FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council has applied for the sum of \$45,000.00 to make additional improvement at Reservation Lake, and


WHEREAS, improvements of facilities at Reservation Lake are of the utmost importance to the success of the recreation and tourism program of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the further development of facilities at Reservation Lake will stabilize employment for members of the Tribe and provide recreational facilities for thousands of fishermen and tourists on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a request for a grant be made by the Chairman of the Tribal Council through the Bureau of Indian Affairs to obtain the amount of \$45,000.00 for this much needed improvement.

The foregoing resolution was on September 3, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
