

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the First National Bank of Arizona is now contemplating establishing a bank at Whiteriver, Arizona, and

WHEREAS, the bank has inquired of the possibility of leasing land for construction of homesites for bank employees.

BE IT RESOLVED that if and when homesite lease land becomes available for non-Indians that the future bank employees of the First National Bank, to be established at Whiteriver, shall have a right to lease said lands from the Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on September 3, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
