


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Fort Apache Timber Company has promised to advance the sum of \$1500.00 for the water and sewerage project for the twenty (20) 221 D3 FHA houses on the Fort Apache Timber Company Housing Project, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that an additional sum of \$3500.00 be appropriated by the Tribe as and for the tribe's share (10%) of the cost of the water and sewer project to be installed by U. S. Public Health Service through PL 86-121.

BE IT RESOLVED there is hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit with the U. S. Treasury the sum of \$3500.00 to be used to defray the Tribe's share of the cost of Fort Apache Timber Company Housing Project for water and sewerage.

The foregoing resolution was on September 3, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
