

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribe has passed Resolution No. 69-80 requesting the Secretary of the Interior to call an election to amend Article VIII, Section 5, of the Constitution of the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, said resolution was approved by the Secretary with some minor modifications, which modifications have been accepted by the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate the sum of \$2,000.00 to defray the cost of said election, and

WHEREAS, it was necessary that an Election Committee be appointed.

BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$2,000.00 is hereby appropriated from funds on deposit in the U. S. Treasury to defray the cost of an election of the White Mountain Apache Tribe for the purpose of preparing an amendment of Article VIII, Section 5, of the Constitution of the Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following two members and an alternate be appointed on the Election Board to-wit: Ivan Kitcheyan, Sidney Ethelbah and Vivian Williams, Alternate.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary is hereby requested to call the election to effectuate the amendment of the Constitution and set October 24, 1969 as the date of the election.

The foregoing resolution was on September 4, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
