WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Save the Children Federation Program has been active on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation from 1966, and


WHEREAS, innumerable children are now sponsored by the said federation program, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the sum of \$3,000.00 be expended by the tribe to match fund grant by the Save the Children Federation Program, and

WHEREAS, this program is of great importance to the Apaches.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the sum of \$3,000.00 is transferred from the contingency funds to the Save the Children Federation fund to match a special grant from Save the Children Federation for home improvement in various communities on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on September 23, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
