

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, U. S. Public Health Service has agreed to construct water and sewerage system for the Carrizo Indian Community including, but not limited to, the Carrizo Mutual-Help Housing Project, Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and


WHEREAS, a resolution requesting the U. S. Public Health Service to construct water and sewerage system for the Carrizo Mutual-Help Housing Project has been adopted by the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority, and

WHEREAS, an agreement has been requested by the U. S. Public Health Service by and between the U. S. Public Health Service and the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority; such agreement having been read to the Tribal Council.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tribal Council is hereby authorized to execute the agreement for the construction of water and sewerage disposal facilities in the Carrizo Indian Community and for the Carrizo Mutual-Help Housing Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman be authorized to execute the agreement with the U. S. Public Health Service.

The foregoing resolution was on September 23, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
