

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Barry DeRose has performed good and faithful service for the White Mountain Apache Tribe and in many cases, in excess of his present contract, and

WHEREAS, the present enterprises and the members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe have progressed with the advice and guidance of Barry DeRose, and

WHEREAS, the growth of all the enterprises have increased the workload of the tribal attorney.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary are hereby authorized on behalf of the Tribal Council to execute a new Tribal Attorney Contract with Barry DeRose for a three-year period beginning May 1, 1969 and terminating on April 30, 1972, at a salary of \$1166.66 per month in the substantial form as read by all of the tribal council members.

The foregoing resolution was on September 23, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (d) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
