FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there is a savings in the educational fund, and

WHEREAS, the Education Coordinator is in great need of an automobile to make the innumerable trips both on and off the reservation that is required.

BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$3,000.00 is transferred from the Educational fund to a fixed asset account to purchase a new automobile to be used by the Education Coordinator.

The foregoing resolution was on September 23, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
