

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, medical emergencies have occurred in the past in which indigent White Mountain Apaches were in need of emergency medical or hospitalization, and

WHEREAS, the tribe desires to establish a fund, not to exceed \$8,000.00 and further granting the Chairman the authority to expend monies from these funds for the said medical emergencies.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is transferred from the contingency fund to the medical emergency fund the sum of \$8,000.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the tribe is hereby authorized to use in his discretion any or all of the said funds for any indigent White Mountain Apache who might be in need of emergency medical or hospitalization.

The foregoing resolution was on September 23, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
