FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Madden's Cafe located at the bottom of the Salt River Canyon on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation has been notified many times before that unsanitary conditions are maintained in said establishment, and


WHEREAS, Mr. Dieteman of the U. S. Public Health Service reported to the Tribal Council that he is unable to persuade Mr. Madden, the Operator, to correct these unsanitary conditions.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Superintendent is hereby requested to notify Mr. Madden that unless the unsanitary conditions are corrected within thirty (30) days that the lease and traders license covering the premises shall be terminated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a carbon copy of this letter be sent to Mr. D. T. Stevens and Mr. Herbert T. Long.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
