

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, U. S. Public Health Service has agreed to construct a water and sewerage system in the Fort Apache Junction Community on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, an agreement has been requested by the U. S. Public Health Service by and between the U. S. Public Health Service and the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tribal Council is hereby authorized to execute the agreement for the construction of water supply and sewerage disposal facilities in the Fort Apache Junction Community, said agreement to be between the tribe and the U. S. Public Health Service.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said agreement be put in the form as read to the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
