WHEREAS, the First National Bank desires a revocable permit to park a trailer as and for a temporary bank, said permit to continue until the final banking structure is completed, and

WHEREAS, it is an advantage to the tribe to have a bank in Whiteriver.


BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and Superintendent are hereby authorized to issue a revocable permit to the First National Bank upon which to locate a trailer bank in the vicinity of the Western States Telephone Utility Office, said site to be approved by the Chairman and the Superintendent.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the trailer may remain on this site until the opening of the permanent structure, provided that construction is started within six (6) months from the date hereof and proceed diligently.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it shall be a gratuitous permit.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
