FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, as part of the tribe's contribution to the Indian Development District of Arizona program there is a delinquent telephone bill in the sum of \$1233.96, and


WHEREAS, the tribe now has a capable Assistant Director of the Indian Development District of Arizona located at Whiteriver, and

WHEREAS, the program now has great merit.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is appropriated from tribal funds on deposit the sum of \$1233.96 as a portion to Indian Development District of Arizona to pay the delinquent telephone bill.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
