

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the tribe had previously approved a three-way tribal agreement employing Fred Kirges as its water advisor, and

WHEREAS, the tribe did not budget any money in its current budget to defray the cost of Kirges' services.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Attorney is hereby authorized to approve the payment of the sum of \$484.49 from the extra legal service item in the currently approved Tribal Budget FY 69-70.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
