


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Branch of Social Services has exceeded its budget in assisting needy children with school clothing, and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that the sum of \$1378.13 will be needed for the remainder of the fiscal year.

BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$1378.13 is hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit with the U. S. Government to be used by the Branch of Social Services for the purchase of tribal school children's clothing for the remainder of the fiscal year.

The foregoing resolution was on December 11, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
