

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the cutting expiration date for the Elk Canyon Logging Unit, Contract No. 14-20-0450-5089, approved by the Area Director, November 13, 1964 between the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Fort Apache Timber Company expires December 31, 1969, and

WHEREAS, the cutting on this unit could not be completed because of volume limitations imposed by Fort Apache Timber Company's Plan of Operation on the Tribal Management Block; therefore, approximately three million board feet remains for cutting, and

WHEREAS, the Fort Apache Timber Company cannot harvest this volume until Calendar Year 1971.

BE IT RESOLVED that the contract cutting expiration date be extended through December 31, 1971 and the date to complete all other contract obligations be December 31, 1972. Also, the Tribal Chairman is authorized to sign all documents pertinent to this extension.

The foregoing resolution was on December 11, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
