

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Office of Economic Opportunity Program extended to the reservation an allowance of funds sometime ago, and

WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States has appropriated funds for the Office of Economic Opportunity which were subsequently approved by the president, and

WHEREAS, the Council has been advised that the extension and refunding of all Office of Economic Opportunity projects on the reservation had been approved by the Office of Economic Opportunity, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Office of Economic Opportunity has a payroll deficit as of this date, and

WHEREAS, Director Robinett has been advised that funds most likely would be available within a short time, and

WHEREAS, the director has further advised the council that funds advanced by the council would be reimbursed to the tribe from the Office of Economic Opportunity funds when they are received.

BE IT RESOLVED that upon the verbal assurance by the Community Action Program Director in the Office of Economic Opportunity in Washington has approved the grant for the White Mountain Apache Office of Economic Opportunity Programs current year's budget, that the sum of \$50,000.00 on deposit in the treasury of the United States to the credit of the White Mountain Apache Tribe be hereby appropriated for use by the White Mountain Apache Office of Economic Opportunity.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the receipt of the Office of Economic Opportunity funds, the total amount advanced to the White Mountain Apache Office of Economic Opportunity Program by the tribe will be reimbursed to the general account of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on December 11, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
