FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Charles Patterson dba Apache Construction Company is going to submit a bid for construction of the new vocational school at Whiteriver, Arizona, EDA Project No. 08-1-00604, and


WHEREAS, the said Charles Patterson employs Apache people and the tribe receives a certain percentage of his gross receipts, and

WHEREAS, it is hoped that said Charles Patterson will be awarded the bid for the construction of the said vocational building.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman of the tribe is hereby authorized for and on behalf of the tribe to guarantee up to the amount of \$30,000.00 any type of performance bond that Charles Patterson is required to make provided he is awarded the contract to construct the vocational school building.

The foregoing resolution was on December 11, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
