

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Bureau of Indian Affairs can invest funds on deposit with the U. S. Treasury Department in the purchase of treasury bills and thereby secure a greater amount of interest for the tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs is hereby authorized and directed to purchase \$250,000.00 in U. S. Treasury bills from funds on deposit by the tribe with the said U. S. Treasury Department.

The foregoing resolution was on December 11, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
