

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the contract for the construction of the vocational school will soon be let, and


WHEREAS, the tribe has borrowed certain sums from Economic Development Administration in order to pay its 20% obligation, and

WHEREAS, this sum is payable at the rate of \$359.16 monthly, and

WHEREAS, the Whiteriver School District No. 20, who is going to operate the vocational school, will not be able to make the monthly payments for approximately three months.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit the sum of \$1077.48 to defray the cost of making the monthly payments on the loan of the tribe to the Economic Development Administration funds contribution cost of the new vocational school.

The foregoing resolution was on December 11, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
