FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Chairman has secured a donation from Save the Children Federation to purchase a garbage truck on the reservation, and


WHEREAS, funds are needed to pay the cost of a truck driver's salary and payroll taxes, and

WHEREAS, this garbage truck is needed for health and sanitation performance on the reservation.

BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$2100.00 is hereby appropriated from savings within the tribal budget to defray the cost of employing a truck driver to operate the newly acquired garbage truck for the balance of the year.

The foregoing resolution was on December 11, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
