FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Alice Pipkins desires to establish a fuel, feed and farm supplies business, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council encourages individual members of the Tribe to seek and establish business ventures.

BE IT RESOLVED that Mrs. Alice Pipkins be granted a permit to sell miscellaneous merchandise.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that she make application for a lease on the premises where the business should be operated.

The foregoing resolution was on February 4, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
