


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, through inadvertence the Tribal Council failed, in Resolution No. 69-88, to include the East Fork area for a basketball court, and

WHEREAS, there is a definite need for a basketball court in the East Fork area.

BE IT RESOLVED that the amount of \$1500.00 is hereby appropriated in savings within the tribal budget to provide for a basketball court in the East Fork area.

The foregoing resolution was on February 4, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
