


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Central Office has advised the Council that it needs typewriters, desks, file cabinets and other office equipment for use in the Central Office and for use in other tribal offices on the reservation, and

WHEREAS, in order to efficiently operate these said offices, these equipment must be purchased.

BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$11,368.65 is hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit in the U. S. Treasury to purchase miscellaneous office equipment.

The foregoing resolution was on February 4, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
