

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is of the opinion that because of the increased cost of living the per diem allowance should be \$25.00 per diem for all employees, including all contract employees.


BE IT RESOLVED that the per diem allowance for all tribal employees shall hereafter be \$25.00 per diem.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise Manager's Contract, the White Mountain Apache Enterprise Manager's Contract, the Fort Apache Timber Company Manager's Contract, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Herd Manager's Contract and the Tribal Attorney's Contract are hereby amended to provide that all of said persons shall likewise receive \$25.00 per diem.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any and all resolutions heretofore passed, which are in conflict with this resolution, are hereby rescinded.

The foregoing resolution was on April 14, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
