FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Economic Development Administration prior to approving loans to construct the Vocational Center and the Fort Apache Timber Company bridge that the tribe secure said loans, and


WHEREAS, the Economic Development Administration would approve the assignment, as security, the Southwest Forest Industries, Inc. lease at McNary, Arizona with the tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council hereby approves the assignment of the Southwest Forest Industries, Inc. lease to the tribe covering the McNary area as security for the payment to the Economic Development Administration, the Vocational Center and Fort Apache Timber Company bridge loans.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman is hereby directed to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the assignment of the lease and the consumation of the loan.

The foregoing resolution was on April 14, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
