

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Council at its last meeting reinstated the sum of \$30,000.00 in the Tribal Attorney's budget as and for extra legal services, and

WHEREAS, the council is of the opinion that there should be established the position of a legislative coordinator, and


WHEREAS, Ronnie Lupe has made application for this position.


BE IT RESOLVED that Ronnie Lupe is hereby appointed Tribal Legislative Coordinator, pursuant to a standard contract beginning May 7, 1970, at a salary of \$9500.00 per annum plus taxes and benefits for a total of \$11,851.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there is further appropriated the sum of \$5,000. plus \$800.00 taxes for the employment of a Secretary and further budgeted the sum of \$1,000.00 for office expenses, telephone and supplies; the further sum of \$3,000.00 for travel and per diem; the sum of \$4500.00 for vehicle purchase; the sum of \$1,000.00 for vehicle expenses and the sum of \$1150.00 for office space and equipment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Attorney is to prepare a standard contract for said position.

The foregoing resolution was on May 4, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
