FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has requested a leadership training program to be carried out for their benefit on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and


WHEREAS, ICAP Project Coordinator, Dr. Mayland Parker has agreed to fund this leadership training program through OEO, and


WHEREAS, Dr. Parker has secured the services of the Foundation Under Neighborhood Development, Arizona State University, and the services of Miss Joan Baller as Director to provide this training.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Foundation Under Neighborhood Development is requested to carry out a leadership training program for the Tribal Council and others on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation to be funded by OEO through ICAP.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this training program will be at no cost to the White Mountain Apache Tribe other than the time for the participants which will be arranged through the Tribal Chairman.

The foregoing resolution was on May 6, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
