

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Maverick Logging Unit, Contract No. I-30 Ind 2481, was purchased by Southwest Forest Industries, Inc. (SWFI) and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on July 19, 1943, and

WHEREAS, the contract expired March 31, 1970, and

WHEREAS, the contract did not allow sufficient time for Southwest Forest Industries, Inc. to complete all of their obligations of the contract i.e. slash disposal, erosion control, cleanup, and a minor amount of scaling at the McNary sawmill, and

WHEREAS, Southwest Forest Industries, Inc. has requested an extension of the Maverick contract through December 31, 1970 to complete these obligations, and

WHEREAS, this extension will not allow further green tree cutting by Southwest Forest Industries, Inc., therefore it will not interfere with sales to the Fort Apache Timber Company within the Maverick sale boundaries.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Maverick Logging Unit Timber Contract be extended through December 31, 1970 to allow Southwest Forest Industries, Inc. the opportunity to complete their contract obligations, provided that no green tree felling is allowed except for the purpose of salvage as deemed necessary by the Approving Officer. Southwest Forest Industries, Inc. should not be required to salvage timber in areas under contract to Fort Apache Timber Company.

The foregoing resolution was on May 7, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
