FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has secured, through the U. S. Public Health Service, Division of Environmental Health Service, Water and sewerage disposal facilities, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council faces the need for training of members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe for proper maintenance of these projects, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council would like to secure proper equipment and tools for maintenance of these projects.

BE IT RESOLVED that the U. S. Public Health Service, Division of Environmental Service is requested to assist the Sanitation Committee of the Tribal Council in working up a program to provide such needed training and equipment.

The foregoing resolution was on May 7, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
