

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has requested and previously received a grant from the Economic Development Administration for the construction of the Sunrise Project Complex, and

WHEREAS, bids have been let for the lodge, driveways, water, sewer, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Jimmy Nunn of Haver, Nunn and Jensen, Tribal Architects have secured bids for a chair lift for the ski run and presented those five bids received to the Tribal Council, and


WHEREAS, the sum of \$316,000.00 is needed to purchase and install a ski lift at the Sunrise Complex, and


WHEREAS, unless this sum is appropriated the complex will fail.

BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$316,000.00 on deposit in the treasury of the United States is hereby appropriated to purchase and install a chair lift.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that our Architect Engineer Mr. Jimmy Nunn and the committee appointed by the Chairman are hereby authorized to choose the make of ski lift to be purchased.

The foregoing resolution was on May 7, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 4 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
