

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Nelson Lupe, Sr. presented a letter from Mr. M. R. Zbierski, Business Manager, Arizona State Employment Service, which letter requests that a site be set aside for the future use of the Arizona State Employment Service in Whiteriver, and


WHEREAS, the Arizona State Employment Office is of great benefit to the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED that the parcel of land now being used by the First National Bank of Arizona, thereon on said parcel of land is located, a bank office trailer, be set aside as a site for the future use by the Arizona State Employment Service.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if at the termination of the permit, the First National Bank has not yet moved, and if the Employment Service has sufficient funds to construct a building thereon, that the First National Bank move its trailer to the site set aside to it where the bank is to be constructed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the bank does not wish to move said trailer to its future building site, that the Employment Service shall have an alternate site designated or the Council can force the bank to move its trailer.

The foregoing resolution was on June 10, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
