WHEREAS, Mr. John Sullivan recommended to the Tribe that it participate in the Career Opportunity Special Education Program, and

WHEREAS, this would enable many Apache people to become qualified teachers, and


WHEREAS, there is a great need for Apache teachers on the Reservation.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribe hereby agrees to participate in the Career Opportunity Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman is hereby authorized to sign any documents necessary to consummate any agreements between Arizona State University and the Tribe relative to this said educational program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that both public and parochial schools are hereby requested to participate and cooperate with this program.

The foregoing resolution was on June 3, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
