WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Christmas Tree Lake has been operated under a special use program to preserve and propagate the rare Apache Trout, and


WHEREAS, the fish population has now increased to the point that a short open season is felt advisable, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe has received special awards and wide recognition for its efforts in preserving the Apache trout.

BE IT RESOLVED that Christmas Tree Lake shall be opened to fishing from September 1, 1970 to September 30, 1970.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the creel limit at Christmas Tree Lake shall be set at five (5) fish per day for non members and tribal members.

The foregoing resolution was on June 10, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
