

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development has approved and funded construction of 35 low rent houses on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation at Whiteriver, Arizona, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe will serve as prime contractor for the project, and


WHEREAS, the Tribe desires to obtain a qualified, competent Construction Superintendent.

BE IT RESOLVED that Mr. Charles Patterson is hereby approved for the position of Construction Superintendent at a rate of 6.5% of the total construction costs, said fee to include all supervisory and administrative costs accrued to this project,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Attorney is directed to draw a contract between the Tribe and Charles Patterson for this specific project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman and Tribal Secretary are hereby authorized to sign the contract on behalf of the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on July 8, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
