FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is interested in improvement of its business methods, in its tribal business office and other businesses on the reservation operated by its enterprises, and

WHEREAS, the Economic Development Administration has indicated interest in financing this project.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that an application for technical assistance under Section 301 of Public Law 89-136 be submitted to the Economic Development Administration entitled Economic Improvement - Development of Economic Improvement Planning Phase 1.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is hereby authorized and directed to have prepared and submit this application and is further authorized to sign any and all documents necessary to carry out this project.

The foregoing resolution was on July 9, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against and 2 abstained by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
