

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that if the lands between Whiteriver Service Station and Econ-O-Wash were leased to construct a service station and garage thereon, a traffic hazard would develop, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is responsible for the safety of tribal members.

BE IT RESOLVED that Resolution No. 70-108 wherein the Chairman was authorized to sign a lease with Harward Peddie covering said premises is hereby rescinded.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Harward Peddie is to meet with the Land Committee and secure a recommendation from the said Board of a different area upon which he desires to construct a service station and garage.

The foregoing resolution was on August 5, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
