

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the annual Tribal Fair is of great benefit to the White Mountain Apache people, and

WHEREAS, tribal funds are needed to help finance the cost of the Tribal Fair.

BE IT RESOLVED that the expenditure of \$3,000.00 from the Contingency Account is hereby approved to help defray the cost of this year's annual fair.

The foregoing resolution was on August 6, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
