

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Arch Penrod resigned his position as Manager of the White Mountain Apache Enterprise, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Enterprise Board of Directors refused to accept his resignation and all three members requested the Council to likewise refuse his resignation, and

WHEREAS, the majority of the council decided to accept his resignation.

BE IT RESOLVED that Arch Penrod's resignation as manager of the White Mountain Apache Enterprise is hereby accepted effective thirty (30) days from the 9th day of September, 1970.

The foregoing resolution was on September 9, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for 0 against and 3 abstained by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
