WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the U. S. Public Health Service has agreed to construct water and sewerage systems for two specific housing projects designated as Project No. Ariz. 16-1, South Whiteriver, Mutual-Help Housing and Project No. Ariz. 16-7, 35 Low-Rent Housing, both located in the South Whiteriver townsite, on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and


WHEREAS, a Resolution requesting the U. S. Public Health Service to construct a water and sewerage system for said projects has been adopted by the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority, and

WHEREAS, an agreement has been requested by the U. S. Public Health Service, the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority; such agreement having been presented to the Tribal Council.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is hereby authorized to execute the agreements for the construction of the water supply and sewerage disposal facilities in the South Whiteriver Townsite for the above-mentioned housing projects.

The foregoing resolution was on September 30, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
