


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has, for a number of years, employed a State Brand Inspector with the State and the Tribe sharing equally in salary, and

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona has increased the Brand Inspector's salary in the amount of \$50.00 per month effective July 1, 1970.

BE IT RESOLVED that the amount of \$724.00 be appropriated from Tribal funds on deposit in the Treasury of the United States which will provide the Tribe's share of this salary increase from its effective date, July 1, 1970.

The foregoing resolution was on September 30, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
