FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Enterprises Board of Directors have been operating on the Reservation wage scale that is four years old, and


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Enterprise Board, on October 28, 1970, feels that an increase in the White Mountain Apache Enterprise wage scale is necessary for employees due to the increase in cost of living and to be more in line with wages paid off the reservation in similar job classifications.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that they approve the recommended wage scale and the budget amendment of \$29,500 attached hereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council approves the White Mountain Apache Enterprise wage scale and budget amendment of \$29,500 to cover wage increase costs effective November 1, 1970.

The foregoing resolution was on November 4, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
