


RESOLUTION OF THE

FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Alice Pipkins has previously been granted permission to sell hay, grain and fuel as her business in the Seven Mile area, and

WHEREAS, she now desires to add groceries and sundries to her list of saleable items.

BE IT RESOLVED that said Alice Pipkins is granted permission to sell groceries and sundry items in her store in the Seven Mile area.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
