

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Community Action Program is in need of the approximate sum of \$10,000.00 to carry the payroll for said program through February 3, 1971, and


WHEREAS, the continuation of the program on the reservation is of great benefit to the tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Federal officials of the Community Action Program has assured the tribe that it will be reimbursed the sum of \$10,000.00 as it advances same to the local Community Action Program.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit in the treasury the sum of \$10,000.00, said sum to defray payroll cost of operating the White Mountain Apache Community Action Program from now through February 3, 1971.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there is hereby transferred the sum of \$10,000.00 from the funds on deposit in the White Mountain Tribal Herd to the General fund of the tribe, and that as soon as the \$10,000.00 is repaid to the Community Action Program, the Tribal Treasurer will credit the White Mountain Tribal Herd Account in the amount of \$10,000.00.

The foregoing resolution was on December 9, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
