WHEREAS, Judge Kay Lewis had previously offered his resignation as Chief Judge of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Court, and


WHEREAS, the tribe now desires of accepting said resignation, and


WHEREAS, Ida Early is an Associate Judge and could occupy the Chief Judge's position on a temporary basis.

BE IT RESOLVED that resignation of Judge Kay Lewis is hereby effective 8:00 a.m. on the 10th day of December, 1970.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Associate Judge Ida Early is hereby appointed Temporary Acting Chief Judge effective December 10, 1970 at the same salary and fringe benefits as were provided for Judge Kay Lewis.

The foregoing resolution was on December 9, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
