FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Head Start Program expects, within two weeks, to be funded, and,


WHEREAS, it is now in need of the approximate sum of \$15,000.00 to defray the cost of operation pending the receipt of the funds.

BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$15,000.00 is hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit in the treasury, to be loaned to the Head Start Program for an approximate period of thirty (30) days to defray the cost of operating said program until funds are received from the Federal Government.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the sum of \$15,000.00 be transferred from White Mountain Apache Tribal Herd Account to the General fund and that as soon as the said sum of \$15,000.00 is repaid by the Head Start Program, that this sum be credited to the White Mountain Apache Tribal Herd Account by the Tribal Treasurer.

The foregoing resolution was on December 9, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
