
RESOLUTION OF THE

FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the low-rent housing complex is almost completed, and

WHEREAS, the council desires that the Child Protective Agency be given highest priority for two of the five-bedroom homes.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Housing Authority, in charge of the low-rent housing units, is hereby requested to grant to the Child Protective Agency first priority for two, five-bedroom homes.

The foregoing resolution was on January 6, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
