FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Irvin Santiago, the Agency Housing Officer reported on the progress of the Home Improvement Program, the Self-Help Housing Project and the Revolving Credit Program homes on the north Whiteriver townsite area between the Whiteriver Lutheran Church and the Baptist Church, and


WHEREAS, the council is of the opinion that the construction and improvement of homes in this area will not conflict with any of the recommendations of the 701 Report (Comprehensive Plan).

BE IT RESOLVED that the Housing Director and all persons connected with the construction and improvement of said homes within this area are hereby directed to expedite the improvement of the project as soon as possible.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any agency of the Government who are responsible for sewer and water construction in the said area are hereby requested to approve and construct the said sewerage and water system as expeditiously as possible.

The foregoing resolution was on January 6, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
