

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council accepted the resignation of Kay Lewis as Chief Tribal Judge, and

WHEREAS, the said Kay Lewis has withdrawn his letter of resignation, and

WHEREAS, Tribal members have presented to the council, a petition containing enumerable names requesting the Council to reinstate the said Kay Lewis as Chief Tribal Judge, and

WHEREAS, the Council feels that Kay Lewis is qualified for this position.

BE IT RESOLVED that Kay Lewis is hereby reappointed as Chief Tribal Judge effective the 7th day of January, 1971.

The foregoing resolution was on January 6, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 4 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
