FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the tribe sponsors yearly, a Christmas Treat for the children of the reservation, and

WHEREAS, after deducting the donations there is a balance due and owing to the Romney Produce Company for the said candy in the amount of \$242.40, and

WHEREAS, the Council feels this is a very worthy project.

BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$242.40 is hereby authorized to be paid to the Romney Produce Company from the Entertainment Fund, Account No. 09-7905.

The foregoing resolution was on January 6, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
